#### **Basic Function**

The Internal Audit Manager will have two Kosmos auditors reporting to them and is responsible for all operational audits and SOX audit testing. Operational audits include but are not limited to, HSES, Anti-Corruption, AP, Banking, ESG, and Data Security audits. A material number of tested SOX controls are reviewed and relied on by Kosmos' external auditors, EY. The Internal Audit Manager assists the Vice President of Internal Audit on special projects as needed.

### **Essential Responsibilities and Job Duties**

- Lead and participate in Operational, Financial and IT audits with a hands-on approach
- Responsible for audit planning, fieldwork, and report drafting
- Oversee SOX compliance testing, assist where needed, and review workpapers
- Coordinate with external auditors to execute annual SOX controls testing
- Perform special projects and internal investigations as required
- Monitor agreed management actions resulting from previous audits
- Manage workload and performance of auditors, consultants and/or contractors
- Identify potential audits and automate control testing using data analytics
- Handle other projects, duties and responsibilities as assigned.
